



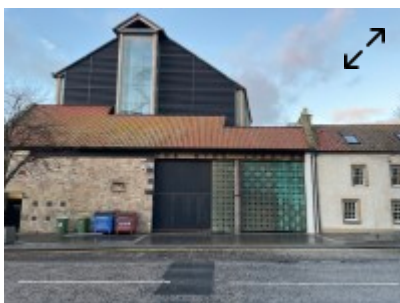

A further two accessible toilets are situated in the backstage area.
- Female and male standard toilet facilities are located on level one and another on level four.
A further standard toilet is situated in the backstage area..
- Parent and baby changing facilities are located in the accessible toilet on level one.

Getting Here

By Road

View

- Travel east along the 918 (South Street) which is one of the main streets through St Andrews, to the roundabout at the junction with Abbey Street. Byre Theatre is on the right hand side of Abbey Street.
- There is free on street parking available outside the Byre Theatre. Pay and Display is in operation for parking bays throughout the town centre during the daytime.

By Bus

View

- St Andrews bus station has links to all major cities. Local bus links throughout Fife and Tayside are also available.

By Train

- The nearest train station to St Andrews is Leuchars, 5 miles outside of St Andrews. The station provides train links to Edinburgh, Glasgow and Dundee. There is a taxi rank at Leuchars train station as well as a regular bus service to St Andrews.

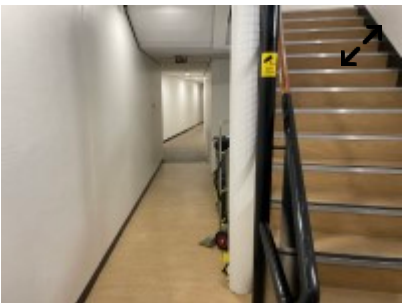

- The entrance door(s) does not/do not contrast visually with its immediate surroundings.
- There is not a bell/buzzer.
- There is an intercom.
- The height of the intercom is 100cm (3ft 3in).
- A key card is required for access at this entrance.
- The height of the key card reader is 100cm.
- The main door(s) open(s) towards you (pull).
- The door(s) is/are single width.
- The door(s) is/are heavy.
- The width of the door opening is 100cm.

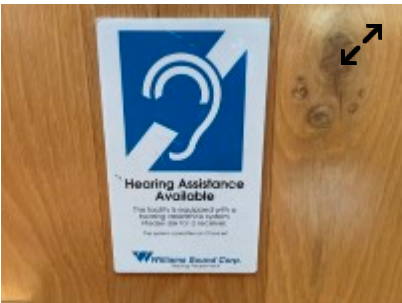
Ramp/Slope

Reception

View

- The reception point is located besides the South Street entrance.
- The reception point is approximately 5m (5yd 1ft) from the South Street entrance.
- The reception area/desk is clearly visible from the entrance.
- There is step-free access to the reception point.
- There is a clear unobstructed route to the reception point.
- There are windows, TVs, glazed screens or mirrors at/behind the reception point which could adversely affect the ability of someone to lip read.
- The reception counter is not placed in front of a background which is patterned.
- The lighting levels at the reception point are good.
- The height of the reception counter is 114cm.

- There is sufficient space to write or sign documents on the counter.
- There is a lowered section of the counter.
- The height of the lowered section at the counter is 90cm.
- There is sufficient space to write or sign documents on the lowered section of the counter.
- There is not a clear knee recess beneath the counter.
- The counter is staffed.
- There is a bell to attract attention.
- Clipboards can be provided to anyone who is unable to use the desk.
- There is not a hearing assistance system at the reception point.
- There is no wayfinding signage available at/close to the reception.
- The type of flooring in the reception area is wood.

Reception Waiting Area

View

- There is a waiting area close to the reception point.
- Access to the waiting area is unobstructed.
- There is bench seating and also a mixture of single seats with and without armrests.
- The hearing loop signage is explaining that the facility is equipped with a hearing loop system for use within the auditorium. Potential users of this assistance are requested to ask for a receiver at the reception desk.

View

- The following information is for the bar.
- The bar is located on the ground floor.
- There is step-free access to the bar.

Service and Menus

View

- Tables cannot be booked in advance.
- There is a bar where drinks can be ordered.
- There is not a hearing assistance system .
- At the time of survey this bar area was acting as a storage for tables, chairs and related items - so not in use.

Service Counter(s)

View

- The height of the counter is 115cm.
- There is a moveable card machine available for payment.
- The type of flooring in this area is carpet.

Tables and Seating

View

- There is ample room for a wheelchair user to manoeuvre.
- Staff can move furniture to make a table accessible to wheelchair users.
- The surface height of the lowest table is 44cm.
- The surface height of the highest table is 66cm.
- No tables are permanently fixed.
- No chairs are permanently fixed.
- Some chairs have armrests on both sides.
- There are also coffee tables, armchairs and bench seats.
- The lighting levels are good.

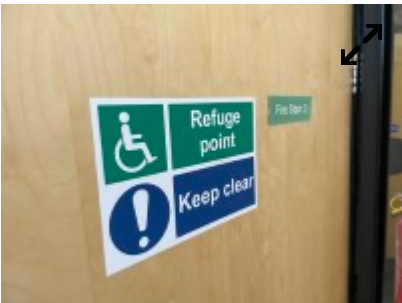

- There is clear signage for building facilities/areas in the foyer/reception area.
- There is clearly written directional signage at key points of circulation routes.
- There is some flooring in corridors which is shiny and could cause issues with glare or look slippery to some people.
- There is high visual contrast between the walls and floor in all areas.
- The lighting levels are good.
- This building does not play background music.
- There is not a hearing assistance system.

Entrance (A.B. Patterson Auditorium)

Entrance

View

- This information is for the entrance located on level 1.
- This entrance gives access to the A.B. Paterson Auditorium.
- The entrance area/door is not clearly signed.
- There is step-free access at this entrance.
- Patrons can use this entrance to access the auditorium at stage level.
Wheelchairs users will use the lift on level 1 to gain access to the back of the auditorium on level 2.

Step(s)

View

- The step(s) is/are located down to the first three rows of seats on either side of the auditorium.
- There is/are 3 steps for the first row of seating, second row has two steps and the third row has one step(s).
- The step(s) is/are clearly marked.
- The height of the step(s) is/are between the recommended 15cm and 18cm.
- The depth of the step(s) is/are between 30cm and 45cm.
- There is not a/are not handrail(s) at the step(s).

- There are designated spaces for wheelchair users.
 - Designated seating is located in at the rear of the auditorium.
 - Wheelchairs are left with you.
 - A companion may sit with you.

- Companions sit next to you.
- It is 8m (8yd 2ft) from the designated seating area to the nearest accessible toilet.
- This venue does not provide audio described performances.
- There is a hearing assistance system.
- The hearing assistance system is a headset.
- Staff are trained to use the hearing assistance system.
- A deposit is not required for the hearing assistance system.
- The hearing assistance system was not tested at the time of the survey.
- There is not a wheelchair to borrow.
- Concessions are available.
- Assistance dogs are allowed in the auditorium.

Steps

View

- The floors which are accessible by stairs are 1, 2, 3 and 4.
- The stairs are located in front of you as enter via the Abbey Street entrance.
- The stairs are approximately 13m from the Abbey Street entrance.
- There are 15+ steps between floors.
- The lighting levels are good.
- The steps are not clearly marked.
- The steps are deep (18cm+).
- The steps do have handrails.
- The steps have a handrail on both sides.
- There is a landing.

Lift

- The lift is located on level one next to the accessible toilet.
- Signs indicating the location of the lift are not available from the entrance.
- The lift is approximately 35m (38yd 10in) from the Abbey Street entrance.
- The lift is a standard lift.
- A member of staff does not need to be notified for use of the lift.
- The floors which are accessible by this lift are 1, 2, 3 and 4.
- The weight limit for the lift is 975Kg.
- Clear signs indicating the facilities on each floor are provided on lift lobby landings.
- There is a clear level manoeuvring space of 150cm × 150cm in front of the lift.
- Lift doors do contrast visually with lift lobby walls.
- The external controls for the lift are within 90cm - 110cm from the floor.
- The visual contrast between the external lift controls and the control plate is low.
- The visual contrast between the external lift control plate and the wall is medium.
- The clear door width is 85cm (2ft 9in).
- The dimensions of the lift are 108cm x 212cm (3ft 7in x 6ft 11in).
- There are not separate entry and exit doors in the lift.
- There is a mirror to aid reversing out of the lift.
- There is a list of floor services available within the lift.
- The lift does have a visual floor indicator.
- The lift does have an audible announcer.
- The internal controls for the lift are within 90cm - 120cm from the floor.
- There is not a hearing loop system.
- The lift does have Braille markings.
- The lift does not have tactile markings.
- The lighting levels in the lift are good.

 - Staff are trained to use the hearing assistance system.

 - The rows suitable for hearing assistance systems are all.

Comments

View

- The hearing loop signage is explaining that the facility is equipped with a hearing loop system for use within the auditorium. Potential uses of this assistance are requested to ask for a receiver at the reception desk. This theatre is a very flexible open space for creative performances. Audiences are on the same level as the performances, the seating can be fluid and organised to suit the specific needs of the performance.

- The width of the accessible toilet opening is 85cm.
- The contrast between the internal door and wall is high.
- The door does not have a horizontal grab rail.

Toilet Features

- The dimensions of the accessible toilet are 200cm x 180cm (6ft 7in x 5ft 11in).
- The accessible toilet does have an unobstructed minimum turning space of 150cm x 150cm.
- The lighting levels are good.
- There is a lateral transfer space.
- As you face the toilet pan the transfer space is on both sides.
- The lateral transfer space on the left is 80cm.
- The lateral transfer space on the right is 82cm.
- The transfer space is obstructed by a female sanitary bin and a waste disposal bin.
- There is a flush on the transfer side.
- There is not a spatula type lever flush.
- There is a lever flush.
- There are dropdown rails on both sides of the toilet.
- The contrast between the dropdown rail(s) and wall is high.
- There is not a/are not wall-mounted grab rail(s) available.
- The contrast between the walls and floor is medium.
- There is an emergency alarm.

- The emergency pull cord alarm was out of reach (higher than 10cm (4") from floor) when surveyed.
- There is not a red flashing fire alarm beacon within the toilet.
- Disposal facilities are available in the toilet.
- There is a/are female sanitary, general waste (with lid) and general waste (with no lid) disposal units.
- There is a/are coat hook(s).
- There are coat hooks in the toilet at 110cm and 134cm from the floor.

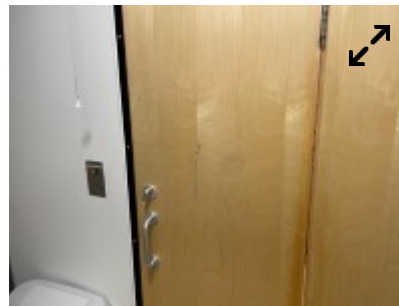

- The width of the accessible toilet opening is 80cm.
- The contrast between the internal door and wall is high.
- The door does not have a horizontal grab rail.

Toilet Features

- The dimensions of the accessible toilet are 183cm x 146cm (6ft x 4ft 9in).
- The accessible toilet does not have an unobstructed minimum turning space of 150cm x 150cm.
- The lighting levels are good.
- There is a lateral transfer space.
- As you face the toilet pan the transfer space is on the right.
- The lateral transfer space is 82cm (2ft 8in).
- The transfer space is obstructed by a female sanitary bin.
- There is a flush, however it is not on the transfer side.
- There is not a spatula type lever flush.
- There is a lever flush.
- There is a dropdown rail on the transfer side.
- The contrast between the dropdown rail(s) and wall is high.
- There is a/are wall-mounted grab rail(s) available.
- As you face the toilet the wall-mounted grab rail(s) is/are on the left.
- There is not a vertical wall-mounted grab rail on the transfer side.
- There is a horizontal wall-mounted grab rail on the opposite side of the seat to the transfer space.
- The contrast between the wall-mounted grab rail(s) and wall is poor.
- The contrast between the walls and floor is high.
- There is an emergency alarm.

- The emergency pull cord alarm was out of reach (higher than 10cm (4") from floor) when surveyed.
- There is not a red flashing fire alarm beacon within the toilet.
- Disposal facilities are available in the toilet.
- There is a/are female sanitary and general waste (with no lid) disposal units.
- There is not a/are not coat hook(s).

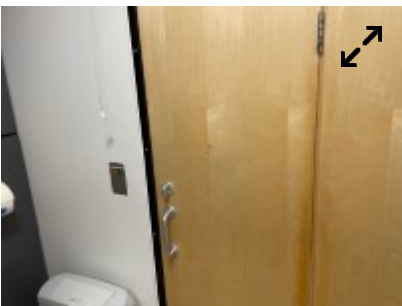

- This accessible toilet is located on level 2 as you exit the lift, turn right through the door, continue on and the accessible toilet is in your right just before the steps.
- This accessible toilet is approximately 14m (15yd 11in) from the lift.
- There is step-free access into the accessible toilet.
- This is a shared toilet.
- A key is not required for the accessible toilet.
- There is Braille, tactile, pictorial and written text signage on or near the toilet door.
- The visual contrast between the external door and wall is high.
- The door opens by sliding (Bi-Fold).
- The door is light.
- The door is locked by a twist lock.
- The width of the accessible toilet opening is 80cm.
- The contrast between the internal door and wall is high.
- The door does not have a horizontal grab rail.

Toilet Features

View

- The dimensions of the accessible toilet are 185cm x 145cm (6ft 1in x 4ft 9in).
- The accessible toilet does not have an unobstructed minimum turning space of 150cm x 150cm.
- The height of the light switch/pull cord is 135cm from floor level.
- The lighting levels are good.
- There is a lateral transfer space.
- As you face the toilet pan the transfer space is on the right.
- The lateral transfer space is 80cm (2ft 7in).
- The transfer space is obstructed by a female sanitary bin.
- There is a flush, however it is not on the transfer side.
- There is not a spatula type lever flush.
- There is a lever flush.
- There is a dropdown rail on the transfer side.
- The contrast between the dropdown rail(s) and wall is high.
- There is a/are wall-mounted grab rail(s) available.
- As you face the toilet the wall-mounted grab rail(s) is/are on the left.
- There is not a vertical wall-mounted grab rail on the transfer side.
- There is a horizontal wall-mounted grab rail on the opposite side of the seat to the transfer space.
- The contrast between the wall-mounted grab rail(s) and wall is high.
- The contrast between the walls and floor is high.
- There is an emergency alarm.
